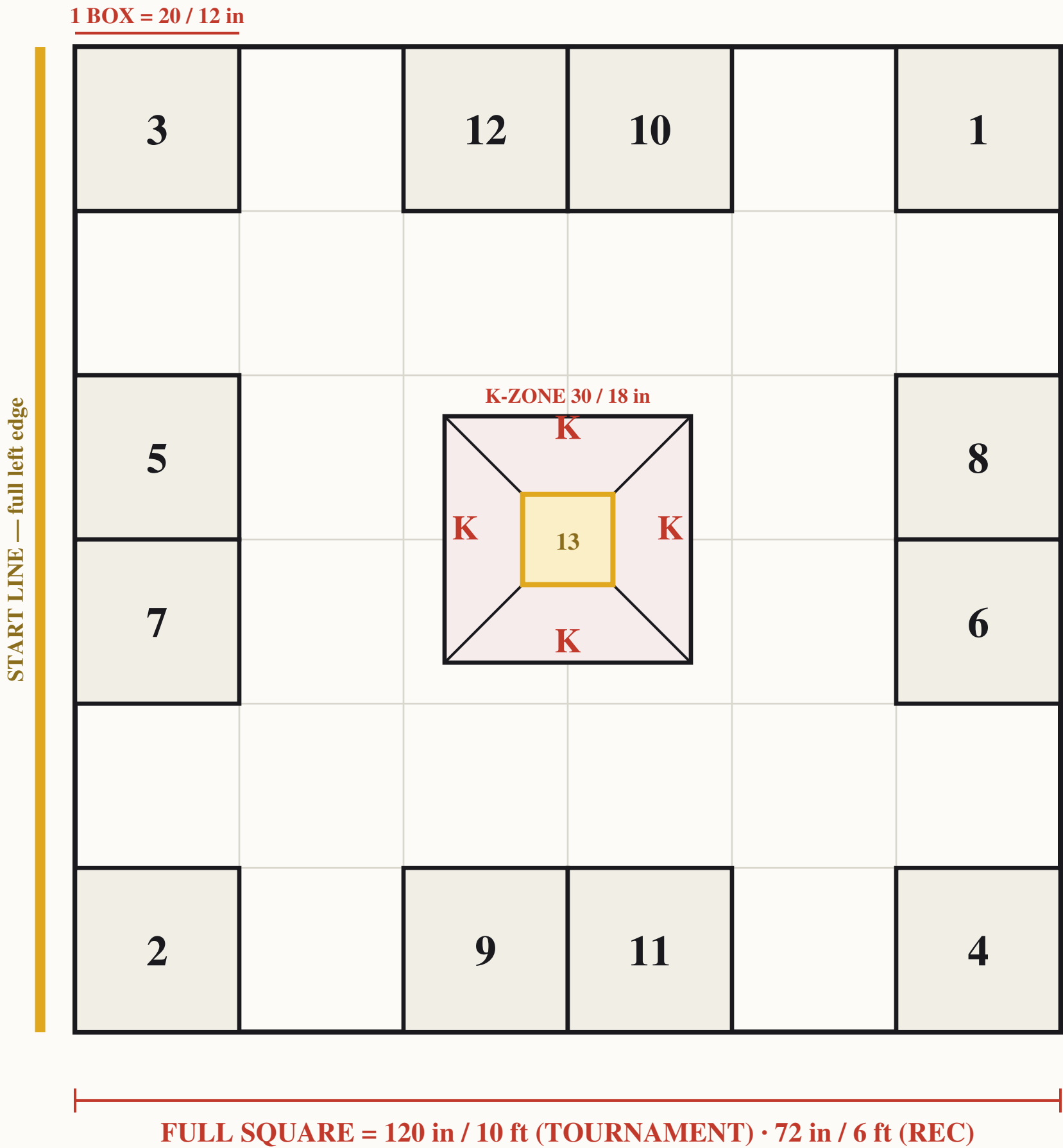


SKELZZY — DRAW YOUR OWN BOARD

CHALK IT • TAPE IT • SPRAY IT • PLAY ANYWHERE



SIZES — pick one, same layout

SIZE	SQUARE	1 BOX	K-ZONE	13 BOX
Tournament — REGULATION • 10 ft	120 in	20 in	30 in	11 in
Recreation • 6 ft	72 in	12 in	18 in	6.6 in
Practice (bonus) • 4 ft	48 in	8 in	12 in	4.4 in

HOW TO LAY IT OUT

- 1 Mark a perfect SQUARE on any flat surface (10 ft tournament / 6 ft rec).
- 2 Divide each side into 6 equal cells (20 in / 12 in each).
- 3 Draw the numbered boxes in the edge cells shown: 3-12-10-1 top, 2-9-11-4 bottom, 5 & 7 left, 8 & 6 right.
- 4 Center: draw the K-ZONE square, split corner-to-corner into 4 triangles (mark each K), box the 13 in the middle.
- 5 Draw the START LINE along the whole left edge.
- 6 Chalk it, tape it, or spray it — then flick. A cap must END fully INSIDE a box to score (touching a line = no count).

ANY SURFACE WORKS.

Blacktop, gym floor, driveway, garage, even cardboard — anywhere flat.
Chalk to practice • painter's tape indoors • spray paint for a permanent court.
